1. OBJET DE LA PROCÉDURE

The procedure describes the submission to the Ethics Committee of a clinical research project on humans performed by a student, future health professional; study performed at the **Cliniques universitaires Saint-Luc (CUSL)**, **de l'UCLouvain** or elsewhere.

2. DOMAINE D'APPLICATION

This procedure is applicable to the members of the CEHF¹ and to the Clinical Trial Center (CTC)

3. DESCRIPTION

3.1. Responsibilities and authorities

The sponsor of a master/bachelor thesis is responsible for the student he/she supervises.

<u>The principal investigator</u> (also called *PI*) must be a health professional (see list in annex) and is responsible for the conduct of the study.

The sponsor of a master/bachelor thesis may be the principal investigator if he/she is a health professional.

<u>The study sponsor in the legal sense of the term</u> (according to the law of 7 May 2004) is a university, a college or an institution to which the student belongs and is responsible for the management and financing of the study

3.2. Description

Any research on the humans aiming to develop knowledge in the field of health care as described in the Belgian law of May 7, 2004, carried out by a student, future health professional, at the end of the first (BAC) or second cycle (Master) of graduate studies and carried out as part of a bachelor/master thesis or carried out by paramedical health professionals who have already graduated and provided that they are submitted as part of a master thesis (public health, psychology, ...), must be submitted for approval by an Ethics Committee.

Research projects not falling within the scope of the law of May 7, 2004 and not requiring a binding favorable opinion from an ethics committee may also be submitted for ethical approval with a view to publication.

A thesis submitted to the Ethics Committee and which concerns a hospital service must have received the prior written consent of a health professional² (doctor, nurse, physiotherapist or

Doctors, dentists, physiotherapists, nurses, midwives, pharmacists, mental health professions and the paramedical professions (pharmacy assistants; audiology; bandaging, orthotics and prostheses; dietetic; occupational therapy; medical laboratory technology; speech therapy; eye care; podiatry; medical imagery; patient transport (excluding the transport of the persons referred to in Article 1 of the law of 8 July 1964 on emergency medical aid); oral care

other, member of the staff of the hospital institution) involved in the project, and who will supervise the study.

The bachelor/master thesis may be:

- either monocentric if it is carried out in a single clinical site or if it is carried out on a population outside a clinical site: the ethics committee is then designated as the "unique" Ethics Committee in Belgium;
- or multicentric if it is carried out simultaneously in several sites: in this case, the thesis project
 must be submitted simultaneously to the Ethics Committees of the various sites and the CEHF³
 is designated as the "main" Ethics Committee, the only one empowered to issue the single final
 opinion, after receiving the opinions of the other Ethics Committees concerned.

The opinion given by the "main" Ethics Committee is unique and binding. It is a condition for the initiation of any study.

The thesis submission procedures, simplified compared to standard procedures, vary according to the type of research carried out:

In the case of a study **not involving patients from Cliniques universitaires Saint-Luc** or a **prospective interventional dissertation consisting solely of non-routine surveys or questionnaires**, or in the case of a **prospective observational dissertation or a retrospective dissertation involving patients from Cliniques universitaires Saint-Luc**,

In the case of a prospective interventional study thesis or an RHBM⁴ thesis involving patients from Cliniques universitaires Saint-Luc,

→ The submission is made via the Clinical Trial Center – CTC. Information can be found on their website at the following page: https://www.saintluc.be/en/student-dissertation

Based on a complete file, the CEHF will analyse the application and may initially formulate a **provisional opinion** (remarks, request for amendments or request for additional information) and, finally, a **final opinion**.

This opinion will then be sent to the **PI**⁵ of the project with a copy to the student within 28 days maximum.

Once the positive opinion of the Ethics Committee has been obtained, any **request for modification** is considered as an amendment, which must also be submitted to the Ethics Committee. From an administrative point of view, an <u>internal CEHF reference number</u> and a unique Belgian registration number (in the case of prospective studies) will be assigned to the project. These shall be mentioned in all correspondence.

- ✓ **Submission form Bachelor/Master thesis**: must be dated and signed by the PI after verification of its contents;
- ✓ Research Summary: 1 to 2 pages maximum, written in French, and must include the title of the project, the objectives, the methodology, the target population (participants), the method of recruitment of participants and the measures taken to ensure the confidentiality of the data;
- ✓ **Protocol**: the templates can be found on the website at the following page: <u>Comité d'Ethique</u> <u>Investigation clinique</u>: <u>soumission initiale</u> | <u>Cliniques universitaires Saint-Luc</u> (<u>saintluc.be</u>);
- ✓ Informed consent form: the templates can be found on the website at the following page:

- ✓ **Insurance certificate**: is a certificate from the sponsor's (institution's) insurance company certifying that the policy complies with the law of 7 May 2004 (no-fault insurance); it can be obtained from the insurance department of the university, college or other institution
- ✓ Budget: defines the financial conditions if costs are incurred

The conformity of the version numbers and dates of the different documents must be checked by the PI⁹ before submission

NB: Ethics Committee meetings are held every Monday (except during school holidays).
